



Joseph A. Citta Scout Reservation

Required Scouting Health Forms and Information

The Joseph A. Citta Scout Reservation requires the following medical information and paperwork for the following scouting programs held at the Citta Scout Reservation.

Family Camp:

Part A and Part B of BSA Medical Form, date of Tetanus immunization, and a copy of both sides of health insurance card.

Cub Scout Day Camp:

Part A and Part B of BSA Medical Form, date of Tetanus immunization, Over the Counter form and Prescription form, and a copy of both sides of health insurance card.

Webelos Adventure Camp:

Part A, B, and C of BSA Medical Form, date of Tetanus immunization, Over the Counter medication form, Prescription medication form, and a copy of both sides of health insurance card.

Boy Scout Resident Camp:

Part A, B, and C of BSA Medical Form, date of tetanus immunization, Over the Counter medication form, Prescription medication form, and copy of both sides of health insurance card.

Part A and B are to be completed at least annually by participants in all Scouting events. The health history, parental/guardian informed consent and hold harmless/release agreement, and talent release statement is to be completed by the participant and parents/guardians. **Part C** is a physical exam that is required for participants in any event when the nature of the event is strenuous and demanding.

Over the Counter Medication Form gives the camp health officer permission to dispense over the counter medications provided by the camp as approved by the parent/guardian.
